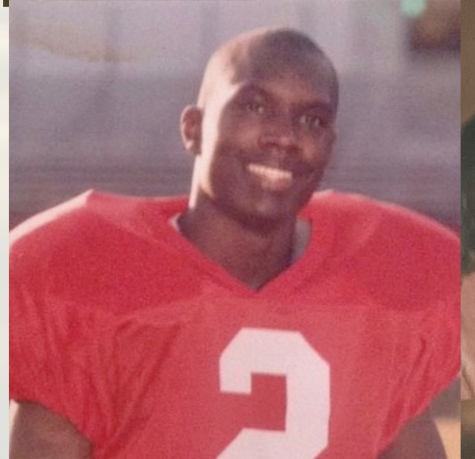
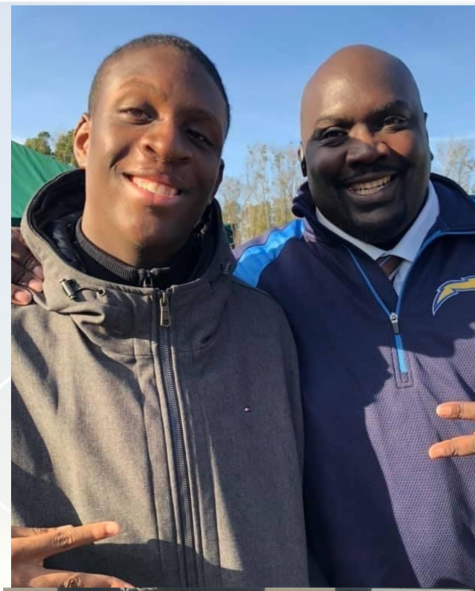

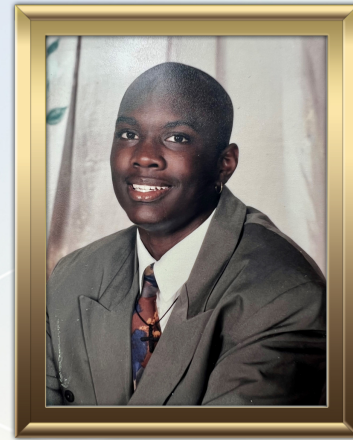

The Obituary

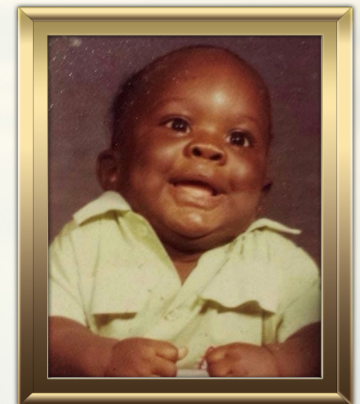
